Our upcoming deadlines are:

□ 2<sup>nd</sup> Deadline: 30 August 2017

Articles can be submitted in German and English language. An article should not exceed 6,000 words (without footnotes) and/or 20 pages. Apart from that conference papers, book reviews (on request) and judgement reviews concerning international humanitarian law with a length of 3–5 pages can be submitted. All articles will be reviewed by the editorial and advisory board.
